



## **6th General Assembly Meeting; Warsaw, 17 – 18 March 2011**

The sixth Nutrimenthe General Assembly meeting will take place in Warsaw, Poland at the Mamaison Le Regina Hotel Warsaw.

The host of the meeting is Children's Memorial Health Institute in Warsaw. The event is coordinated by Medius with kind support of Sequoia company – the partner of Martek in Poland

The Mamaison Le Regina Hotel is situated in the Old Town of Warsaw

During the Warsaw Uprising in 1944, more than 85% of Warsaw's historic centre was destroyed. After the war a reconstruction campaign by its citizens resulted in today's meticulous restoration of the Old Town, with its churches, palaces and market-place. It is an outstanding example of a near-total reconstruction of a span of history covering the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

The hotel is easy to reach from the Frederic Chopin Airport. About 20 minutes by taxi (approximate cost €15).

The fee for this event will be approximately €460. The exact costs will depend on the number of delegates attending. We were lucky to get a special discount for the hotel (almost half of the standard price). The meeting fee – plus personal incidentals – should be paid by each attendee directly to 28<sup>th</sup> February.

In principle the meeting starts in the morning on March 17<sup>th</sup> (the hour depends on which WP or WG you participate in) and ends at 5:00 PM on March 18<sup>th</sup> (see Agenda for full details).
